Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47, I rise to request a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Public Works, Roads and Transport regarding the current state of the Milimani-Yamo Road in Maralal Ward.

Hon. Speaker,

It has come to the attention of the public and this House that the contractor undertaking piping works from Yamo Dam, a National Government project, has extensively damaged the Milimani-Yamo Road during the course of the works. The road, which serves as a critical access route for residents of Milimani and surrounding areas, has become nearly impassable—especially during the rainy season.

In addition, along the same road, the contractor has destroyed household water connection pipes that supply families with water from the Milimani main borehole, resulting in interruption of access to clean and safe water for several homes. This has caused untold suffering and inconvenience to residents who now lack a basic essential service.

This situation raises serious concerns about inter-agency coordination, protection of public infrastructure and essential services, and the need for enforcement of restoration and compensation obligations where public and community assets are damaged by third-party projects, including those implemented by the National Government.
