MOTION

Hon. Speaker, Pursuant to standing order no. 47, I beg to move the following motion;

AWARE, that, the department of livestock bought and distributed camels to the residents of Samburu East and Samburu North wards

FURTHER AWARE, that, the Camels were meant to cushion livestock farmers from the previous long drought that ravaged livestock in the county whereby farmers lost a good number of their animals and for many households all their livelihoods.

OBSERVING, that the camels bore no identification marks made by the department to identify them and no documentation provided to the beneficiaries to prove ownership of the camels provided to them.

DEEPLY CONCERNED, that, there have been reports of the neighboring Borana herders claiming the livestock provided by the county government and due to lack of documentation the beneficiaries have been unable to prove ownership of the distributed camels.

FURTHER AWARE, that; the beneficiaries of these camels can be taken advantage by anyone with ill will due to lack documentation to prove ownership hence the residents have been uneasy

THEREFORE, This **house resolves that** the department of Agriculture, livestock and veterinary services;

1. Initiate an identification mark on all camels and any other livestock distributed in the last financial year and in the future
2. Develop documentation to prove ownership of the camels and all other livestock distributed to the beneficiaries across the County.
