## **STATEMENTS**

**MCA Loosuk Ward,** (Hon: Lenamparasio Phelix): Thank you Mr. Speaker, pursuant to Standing No. 47 I rise to request a Statement from the chairperson on the Sectoral Committee Educational and Vocational Training regarding the status of the implementation FY 2024-2025. The bursary program is a critical line for learners and vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds in Samburu County as a devolved function under the county government the effective equitable implementation remains a key priority in supporting access to education. However there has been a growing concern from my people of Loosuk ward regarding the delayed disbursement and clear beneficiary bursary selection and lack of transparency in the implementation of the 2024-2025 bursary program. I therefore seek clarification from the chairperson of the following issues.

- 1) What was the total approved allocation for bursaries under FY 2024-2025?
- 2) How much has been received and made available for bursary disbursement during the said financial year?

- 3) What is the implementation status of bursary program of today including stages completed and any challenges encountered?
- 4) Provide a comprehensive list of all bursary beneficiaries for the FY 2024-2025 disaggregated by institutions levels secondarys and tertiary institutions.
- 5) Why is it that there is no beneficiaries for Loosuk for Development Fund allocation have benefited despite me as the MCA submitting a list to the Fund Administrator on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2025?
- 6) When will the verified and rightful beneficiaries for Loosuk Ward receive their bursary allocation for FY 2024-2025 that one regarding to my ward fund allocation. Mr. Speaker the County government must uphold the principle of fairness, accountability, and responsive in administering the bursary program. Any delay omission, misallocation direct affects the education of children in marginalized communities.

I urge the chairperson to treat this matter with utmost urgency and ensure that a comprehensive and accurate response is brought to this House at the soonest opportunity. I had made this Statement intentionally because during the FY 2024-2025 I had allocated in my ward fund 2 million bursaries. I think the Department usually deduct 3% which is sixty thousand, I have the right to ask for my 1,940,000/= I had submitted a list to the fund administrator on 11<sup>th</sup> September I have a copy that has been received by him and up to now no beneficiary has received that bursary.

I have 68 tertiary beneficiary and 100 for secondary, so because me I do not fear the government, I have to ask my bursary, I do not know if this will be brought to light but within the seven days that is required by the Standing Orders. I want a response from the Department detailing why the beneficiaries for Loosuk have not received their Ward Fund bursary.

I will not talk about other wards I believe each and every ward has a representative, I am very specific on my ward. That is the reason I have made this I do not know, I just want to ask government MCAs that do not be used, so that during the response you come and defend the government here because my 1,940,000/= has to be accounted for.

**Temporary Speaker,** (Hon. Lelenkeju Jackson): Hon. Lenamparasio respect the House, concentrate on the Statement.

**MCA Loosuk Ward,** (Hon: Lenamparasio Phelix): ...and that is what I am doing.

**Deputy Speaker,** (Hon. Lelenkeju Jackson): (inaudible) the Statement not about...

**MCA Loosuk Ward,** (Hon: Lenamparasio Phelix): No I am asking I know you are the government

**Deputy Speaker,** (Hon. Lelenkeju Jackson): Stick to your Statement...

**MCA Loosuk Ward,** (Hon: Lenamparasio Phelix): I am sticking to my statement and you are starting to defend the government before even the response

*(Laughter)*

**Deputy Speaker,** (Hon. Lelenkeju Jackson): that is irrelevant what is your Point of Order Hon. Loloju?

*(Point of Order from Hon. Loloju)*

**MCA Maralal Ward,** (Hon. Loloju Joseph): Mr. Speaker Hon. Lenamparasio seems to have forgotten his role he belongs to Kenya Kwanza, this government is his, and he formed this government. We as AZIMIO Coalition we are in the opposition side. He should stick to his side, this government is his, belongs to him and so he has the role to deal with his own government not us, thank you

**Deputy Speaker,** (Hon. Lelenkeju Jackson): Hon. Lenamparasio please sit down...

**MCA Loosuk Ward,** (Hon: Lenamparasio Phelix): Mr. Speaker for Hon. Loloju You are in AZIMIO... *(Please sit down kindly direct yourself... Hon. Lenamparasio?)* And you are the one clapping for this government I am not clapping for this government your ward bursary has not been disbursed you are not asking, I am asking mine so continue clapping to... *(Hon. Lenamparasio please sit down)* the government you are the opposition I will not clap for this government.

**Deputy Speaker,** (Hon. Lelenkeju Jackson): Hon. Members it is important to note that this is a House of rules and we must stick by the rules and respect pertains to this House. I cannot see the Chair for Education Committee in the House any other Member of Education Committee can give direction on when he think you can sufficiently answer the Hon. Member for Loosuk Ward.
