QUESTIONS AND STATEMENTS

MCA, Loosuk Ward, (Hon. Lenamparasio Phelix): Thank you so much Mr. Speaker. Pursuant to our Standing Order number 54/C, I hereby request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Committee on Education and Vocational training regarding the implementation status of the Bursary Fund for the Financial Year 25/26. The County Bursary Fund is a vital lifeline for many learners across our 15 wards in our County, particularly those enrolled in secondary schools, colleges, universities, and vocational training institutions. These institutions rely on timely fee payments to sustain operation, while students depend on Bursary support to remain in class. Any delay in implementation directly disrupt learning, increases absenteeism, and exposes vulnerable students to the risk of dropping out.

Education institutions have already commenced for midterm as per the academic calendars, and fee demands have been issued to parents and guardians. Without prompt disbursement of the Bursary Fund for the Financial Year 25/26, students from needy backgrounds are unable to report back to the schools or sit for the exams. This undermines the objective of this fund and defeats the intention of the House when it approved the allocation. So, Mr. Speaker, in the view of the above, I request the Chairperson of the Education Committee to inquire and report to this House on the following issues;

1. How much was allocated by the Department for the Bursary Fund for the Financial Year 25/26, inclusive of the Ward Fund Allocation?
2. When will the Department disburse the Bursary Fund for the respective beneficiaries?.
3. What assurance can the Department provide on timely disbursement of the Bursary Fund, bearing in mind that no clear process has been initiated to date, with only three months remaining to the end of this Financial Year.

Thank you, Mr. Speaker, just to add on some few issues, I think you remember that the whole of last year I have been asking about the Bursary for the 24/25, which was not available to the students for tertiary institutions and our Ward Funds as well. The executive has been using the issues of the Control of Budget to say that that is the reason as to why the Bursary was not disbursed, but recently it is everywhere in the media. I even attended UDA meeting in State

House, I hope you were also present, when the President said that there is no reason again now not to issue students Bursary.

You know we only have three months to the end of this Financial Year, a number of our students have not even reported to schools, especially the grade 10 students. It is not prudent that in this House we allocate money for Bursary, inclusive of Ward Funds, and we still have our kids back home who are unable to attend schools. I hope this time around my Statement will be taken very seriously, and it will be responded to as I requested. With your wisdom here and your guidance, I hope this time around this Statement will be taken very seriously. Thank you Mr. Speaker.

Chairperson, Committee on Medical Service, Public Health and Sanitation, (Hon. Leitoro Jeremiah): Thank you Hon. Speaker. I beg to move the Motion **THAT**; The Samburu County Health Improvement Financing Bill, 2025 (Samburu County Bills No. 1) be now read a third time.

The Speaker, (Mr. Lenamarle Stephen): Hon. Members, I now Propose the Question **THAT**; The Samburu County Health Improvement Financing Bill, 2025 (Samburu County Bills No. 1) be now read a third time.

The Speaker, (Mr. Lenamarle Stephen): Hon. Members, you can have a small interaction on the Bill. Hon. Leitoro.

Chairperson, Committee on Medical Service, Public Health and Sanitation, (Hon. Leitoro Jeremiah): Hon. Speaker, I request to speak after the last person.

The Minority Leader, (Hon. Leleruk James): Thank you Hon. Speaker. Hon. Speaker, I rise to support the Bill, I will like to thank the Committee for the good Report brought to this House, it really touches all the concerns within our hospitals.

The Committee raised a pertinent issue on capacity building of Health Facilities Management Committees and it is good because; for proper management of this fund, these committee need to be thoroughly trained because when this money will be available within the facilities or the

hospitals, we need people who understand it and, Mr. Speaker, this Bill tries to cure some problems that we have been having within our hospitals, like shortage of essential medicines that require to be procured urgently.

This Bill has come at the right time, our hospitals will get enough money without even waiting, the money that we are appropriating as a County so it is upon the hospitals to do their work and ensure that they have enough drugs, they have enough personnel and they must make sure that they market for their hospitals so that they can get enough funds to maintain and sustain what they require to be done.

Also, Mr. Speaker, we recommend that when the Members pass this Bill, we urge the County Government to make sure that all facilities be provided with accountants because if there are no accountants in those facilities; maybe there will be a challenge on how this money will be appropriated. Now is a high time because most of the hospitals do not have accountants, this arises a question that accountants must be employed across all our facilities so that they can help these committees to do their work properly.

Also, Mr. Speaker, I think the CECM will give out the regulations very quickly and provide regulations that try to cure some gaps that are within the Facilities Improvement Financing Act so that the hospitals will not have so many problems.

Mr. Speaker, I urge all Hon. Members, let us pass this Bill because it will help our people and also our health Department will get some funds to be able to provide essential services to our people, thank you Mr. Speaker.

Chairperson, Committee on Medical services, Public Health and Sanitations, (Hon. Leitoro Jeremiah): Thank you Hon. Speaker, may I take this opportunity to thank all Members of the Committee for their valuable contribution and inputs during the deliberations on the Bill both at Committee levels and during the various meetings with the stakeholders as well as the public. May I also thank all the Members of the County Assembly for the dedication and hard work during the public participation exercise and also my sincere gratitude to general public for the cooperation they have offered the committee during the public participation exercise and for turning out in large numbers to participate in the exercise. I also wish to thank your office and

the Office of the Clerk on behalf of the Committee for the logistical support accorded to the members of the committee during the entire period of the deliberation on the Bill up to the Report making period.

The Samburu County Health Improvement Financing Bill, 2025 was first read first time pursuant to Standing Order 139 and thereafter committed the Committee on Medical Services Public Health and Sanitation for consideration in accordance with the Standing Orders of this Assembly. The objective of the Bill was to establish the Samburu County Health Improvement Financing Fund to provide a structured legal mechanism for retention, management, utilization and accountability of revenue generated by public health facilities within Samburu County. We are all aware that revenues that were being generated from all our public hospitals were remitted directly to CRF account therefore the health facilities would not access such revenues when need be.

Currently health facilities collect revenues from research fees, insurance reimbursement and other approved service charges, however delays in accessing such revenues through the County Revenue Fund have negatively impacted service delivery procurement of essential medicine, emergency response and routine operation at health facilities. This Bill now will enable the hospital management to access this fund and enhance service delivery through procurement of essential medicine, emergency response and routine operation at facility level without much struggle as they went through before when we used to remit this revenue through the CRF account.

Some of key issues that were raised during our public participation for consideration were;

- The need for timely access to funds at health facilities of which this CFI Bill is now going to help us with this issue of timely access,
- Reduction of bureaucratic delays in procurement of essential drugs and medical supplies for example a hospital like Baragoi sub-county hospital, when some drugs get out of stock the management at the hospital or any level will be able to buy drugs directly without following the bureaucratic delays and the normal procurement process and this will enable the healthcare workers to attend to these emergencies without much delay. This will improve service delivery standards in all our levels of healthcare facilities.

The Bill will also strengthen the facility autonomy merging operational and also enhancing accountability through clear defined management and structure.

Some of the recommendations that were include;

- The need for clear oversight mechanism to prevent misuse of funds, because this might create leeway for people to misappropriate funds so there is need for clear oversight mechanism to prevent that,
- Capacity building for health facility management committee so that they can efficiently use this fund,
- Need for clear reporting obligation to the County Assembly through the committee of health and other essential committees or any other essential committee,
- Need for periodic audits to ensure compliance with the Public Finance Management Act; as much as we have given them the autonomy to use this revenue at source, they are still obligated to follow the Public Finance Management Act,
- There is need to have a clear guidelines on procurement and expenditure threshold.

With that observation, once again I want to thank the Hon. Members of the County Assembly of Samburu the Secretariat for helping us ensure that this Bill has passed. It has taken us long because the first reading was done April, 2025 it has taken us long but the end of the day today we are celebrating the Act in place, thank you Hon. Speaker.

MCA, Loosuk Ward, (Hon. Lenamparasio Phelix): Thank you so much Hon. Speaker, first of all before I say something I just want to bring the attention of this House that we need a lot of your guidance here especially what we are doing here because the chair who has just sat down is doing what he should have done during the proposal of the question when we approved the Report as the head of this is a House of rules and as head of this institution you should be guiding us very clearly on what we should be doing. I think we had approved this Report long time ago before we went to the Whole house session and I don't think there was any other reason for the Honourable Chair to read what he is reading after we have approved this Report.

This is a Bill and I understand the process of a Bill, we approve this Bill and then after it will be assented by the Governor and then it will be used immediately. This is a Money Bill so I am very interested in the committee recommendation. If you go to the recommendation number 4; (the

fund to be subjected to oversight by the County Assembly in accordance with Article 185 (3) of the Constitution). If you read Article 185(3) of the Constitution it reads; the County Assembly while respecting the principle of separation of powers may exercise oversight to the County Executive Committee and any other County executive organs. I am not interested in that, immediately maybe from next week our hospitals will start implementing these FIF so they will be using the money at their source.

If I was in this Committee what we would have done is maybe underline or highlighted some timelines on regulations because regulations should go hand in hand with this Bill. What will happen if this Bill is being implemented from next week then we take some two years for regulations to be in place, what will happen? Because that can be possible, we start using that money from next week from source but maybe after some two years you go and ask about regulations and there will be none from the executive, how then will we have some timely reporting because article 183 clearly states that the County Executive Committee Member for health submit periodic performance and financial reports to the county assembly pursuant to article 183(3). Regulations are the ones that will help us achieve this, so the committee could have given the CEC or the Department some timeline for the regulations to be in place otherwise if we do not have these regulations people will be using the money from the source but it will be difficult for this House if we want to do some oversight. So if there is any way we can ask the Department that after this time we have to have regulations for this Bill to take effect because if this money is used from the source without regulations then we will be having a very big problem in this County because this money will be misappropriated by the people in charge and this House will have no power to hold them because we have no regulations in place and regulations are what will guide us very clearly on how to do oversight over these funds. We want to oversight these funds so that the money collected from the source will be used very prudently for the help of our health sector, thank you honourable Speaker.

Chairperson, Committee on Medical Services, Public Health and Sanitations, (Hon. Leitoro Jeremiah): Thank you Mr. Speaker, I want to inform my colleague Hon. Lenamparasio Kaunda that he should not be taking us back I know he was not there yesterday so he does not even understand what transpired and we cannot go back yet he himself was aware that he was supposed to be in this in this honourable House.

(Hon. Lenamparasio interjects)

MCA, Loosuk Ward, (Hon. Lenamparasio Phelix): Hon. Speaker, is it in order for hon Leitoro to say that just because I was not around yesterday is the reason I have asked that question? How many times has he missed this House and nobody said so. I have asked this question because that is how I am understanding this Bill, and even if I was not here yesterday that was not supposed to be the way to be told that, I was asking about regulations I need to be told about how regulations...

(The speaker instructs Hon. Leitoro to take his seat and let Hon. Lenamparasio finish)

...that is not supposed to be the way to be responded to, otherwise the Honourable Member should know that.

Chairperson, Committee on Medical Services, Public Health and Sanitations, (Hon. Leitoro Jeremiah): Hon. Speaker this Report was tabled yesterday and we had and the same Report was read so the Hon. Member to take us back on claims that we did not take the Reports as stated, and in terms of regulations they always come after the Bill has been passed. You cannot prepare regulations when the Bill itself has not been passed and the timeline for regulations. It might take some time have the regulations so I am unable to tell you exact timeline for the regulation to be in place. If the Honourable Member had concerns from day one he should have raised that issue, he cannot do that when we are already in third reading, thank you Hon. Speaker.

The Speaker, (Mr. Lenamarle Stephen): Honourable Members I now propose **THAT**, the long titled, The Samburu County Facilities Improvement Financing Bill, 2025 be part of the Bill.

(Question put and Motion passed)
