## **STATEMENTS**

**The Speaker,** (Mr. Lenamarle Stephen): Hon. Members, it is notified that the Speaker has approved the following response for Statements today, Wednesday, May 6th, 2026 at 9:30 a.m. Pursuant to Standing Order 54(c). **Statement No. 001/2026** requested by Honourable Felix Lenamparasio MCA, Loosuk Ward, to the Chairperson of the Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works regarding the implementation status of Loosuk Ward road projects for Financial Year 2023/2024 and 2024/2025.

Hon. Minority Leader.

**Member, Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works,** (Hon. Leleruk James): Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Statement on the implementation status for Loosuk Ward road projects for Financial Year 2023/2024 and 2024/2025, I have it here. Honourable Lenamparasio, who is the author of the Statement, is not around and he asked it be deferred until next week so that we can answer it fully because he is the one who has requested it. I have the response, if you do not mind, I can read. However he has requested it be deferred. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

**The Speaker,** (Mr. Lenamarle Stephen): If the Member has requested, then we can accept. Therefore, the Statement is deferred to next week, Tuesday, 2:30 p.m.

**Statement No. 004/2026** requested by Honourable Leleruk James MCA, Suguta Mar Mar Ward, to the chairperson of the Committee on Lands and Physical Planning regarding the ongoing infrastructure development activities in Nasur village by Baringo County Government as the said developments are still continuing. Any Member of Committee on Lands?

Hon. Nakinyi yesterday said that the response is ready. I do know why.

**MCA Suguta Mar Mar Ward,** (Hon. Leleruk James): Mr. Speaker, I think Hon. Nakinyi yesterday said the Report is ready and we deferred it until today 9:30 a.m. The information that I am receiving is maybe that the CEC has not signed the Report. How can a CEC not sign a Report if he has fully written the Statements and just the signing is required?

So, Mr. Speaker, I want you to give a direction on this issue because it is an emotive issue, a serious issue. Not an issue that we are just asking because it needs an attention of the whole House. You can give us a direction because there is no Member of Lands Committee who

is around. The Clerks are saying the CEC has not signed the Report. I do not know how true that is. So, Mr. Speaker, I think you are the one to give the direction.

**Specially Elected MCA, (Hon. Lenamatiyio Silapia):** Thank you Mr. Speaker. I am not a Member who requested this Statement or the Member for the Lands Committee. But this House or the administration, the Office of the Clerk is developing a culture of taking this House the way they want. If they noted that the Statement was here yesterday as said by Hon. Nakinyi, they could have not even received that it, which I do not know.

Second, I know you have the list of the Members who are in the official duty, those who are in Mombasa. The rest of are within Maralal even some of them were just here some minutes ago. They have taken this House just anyhow, somebody can just walk and go about his own business when the House is on. I think that is a serious matter and with your guidance and leadership, we need the activeness of this House. How can Members neglect their duties that have been assigned by the Constitution of Kenya and also by the people of Samburu who elected them.

It will be so shameful if a mwananchi enters here to the to the panel and observes how empty the House is and Members are not on official duty. I know they are not even reporting to you. This is a very serious matter because we could have heard from the Member for Lands Committee on the response of the Statement. They stated yesterday that they will bring that response here today. What happened? We cannot imagine things. We want reality and we are here blaming the Executive all the time when we are failing ourselves. We need a Kamukunji to address these issues because this is very serious.

**MCA, Nachola Ward, (Hon. Lorunyei Lawrence):** Mr. Speaker, also listening, I support Hon. Silapia. It is us talking to ourselves. Now, if the Assembly is talking to itself, it is somehow abnormal that is why I concur with her. We have our Kamukunji and then have our in-house talk. But having our in-house in a plenary like this means that we are fools. Because a failure talking too is failing, but talking to who? That is why I said it is shameful. We need your guidance to correct our in-house working system. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

**MCA, Suguta Marmar Ward, (Hon. Leleruk James):** Mr. Speaker, I think the Members have raised a pertinent issue and you need to address it. I know the Chair, Honourable Leshimpiro is mourning and maybe the Vice Chair should have been here. The reason why we usually say

these issues should be put on the website so that Members know when their Reports are supposed to be responded to. It is very shameful if we cannot find even a Member to respond as a small issue that he or she can call the CEC or the Clerk of that office so that we know where this Statement is. The whole of this week we have been bashing about our Clerks and they are doing a good job. Now, the responses maybe if the Executive are not the one to producing, I think it is now upon you to give direction on the issue of this House. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

**The Speaker,** (Mr. Lenamarle Stephen): Hon. Members, now that we are told yesterday that the response is ready, it only awaits the signing of the CEC. Therefore, I direct that this Statement should be put in the Order Paper today afternoon because the response is already there and it has not yet reached the Clerk's office. It is still at the Executive and the information they are giving us is CEC has not signed. So, I am directing the Clerk assistants to follow up so that we get the response today at 2:30 p.m. The issue of Kamukunji, we will have it next week Tuesday after the morning session so that we can discuss about the attendance of the House, Thank you.
